

2.7000 BOARD, SCHOOL SELF-EVALUATION

Legal Reference: G.S. 115-C-238.29B(b)(6)

Cross Reference: Falls Lake Academy, Inc. By-Laws

The FLA Board shall undertake periodic self-evaluation of its own processes, procedures, and effectiveness. In most cases, this process shall be conducted in conjunction with an overall self-evaluation of the school's effectiveness as it relates to the school's mission.

Self-evaluations may be undertaken at any time, and as often as the Board chooses to conduct one, but not less than once annually at the end of the school year.

The following data shall be collected and reviewed in the course of Board/school self-evaluation:

- End-of-Grade and End-of-Course Test results
- Any additional standardized test data generated during the course of the school year
- Report of the annual financial audit
- Results of the NC Teachers' Working Conditions Survey, when available
- Survey results and qualitative data collected from the annual administration of a comprehensive survey of school and Board programs, procedures, student performance, and learning outcomes from the FLA staff, the parents, and selected student grades
- School discipline and attendance records
- Complaints and investigations follow-up reports
- Any other information which the school and/or the Board collects and/or submits, or which is reported, as part of the NC School Report Card data collection and reporting process

The Board shall issue a report of its findings in the self-evaluation process for review by the community and the school's constituent populations.
