6th Graders at Falls Lake Academy Build Birdhouses and Raise Money for ACIM

Sixth-grade students at Falls Lake Academy have been working with their teachers to complete a project designed to give back to their community. Students were learning about hunger in the community in their Project-based Learning class. The students heard about the needs in our community from the director of the ACIM. One of the solutions they came up with to address this problem was to have a fundraiser. The sixth-grade teachers decided that building birdhouses would be a perfect tie-in with the concepts they had been working on in math and science classes. Students worked in collaborative groups with each other to design and build their birdhouses (with some outside help from community members). The project culminated with their Presentations of Learning where they shared what they had learned and done with parents and others. A silent auction was conducted alongside the presentations and bids were placed by parents, staff, and visitors. The students were able to raise a total of \$1,266.00 to donate to the ACIM.

Special Congratulations!


