High School Plan



The FLA Board of Directors has approved the operational and educational plan for Falls Lake Academy High School, which will open its doors with its first entering freshman class in August, 2015. The Plan is both ambitious and rigorous, with a seriously strong emphasis on college preparation. The Plan is posted on the FLA website; we encourage all parents, especially parents of current middle school students, to check it out and read it very thoroughly. On Thursday September 23rd, we invite all interested students and parents – especially 8th-grade students and their parents – to meet at 6:30pm to go over the expectations for FLA High School in detail. In the meantime, read the Plan and start developing the questions you may want to ask at the September 23rd meeting!

Lunches

The lunch system for this year is basically the same as last year, but we have expanded our vendor selections for those of you who want to order hot lunches online. Please note that the parents of all students are responsible for providing lunch for their kids every day; FLA has no cafeteria and does not participate in the federal School Lunch program. Parents have two options for providing lunch: **1**) pack and send them from home, or **2**) order them online once each quarter, pre-paid, and they will be delivered to the school at lunchtime each day.

This year's vendor-provided hot lunch options:

Friday	Chick-Fil-A or El Rio (both are offered on Fridays, make your choice)



The window for online lunch ordering for the first quarter will open on <u>Monday July 28th</u> and will close on <u>Wednesday August 20th</u>. Lunches ordered during this time will start delivery on Monday August 25th and end on Friday October 24th. **Please note that all students must bring their own packed lunches from home for the first week of school, August 18th through 22nd, until vendor lunches begin delivery on August 25th**.

Final bit of lunch news: this year we will be selling bottled water, fruit juice, Hi-C or similar drinks, and Gatorade G2 at the concession stand during lunchtime. In addition, there will be a Gatorade machine outside the gym open for student use throughout the day. As per your requests, we will *not* be selling soft drinks to kids during the school day, but they may be available for sale from the concession stand after school. Students are still encouraged to bring their own bottled drinks for their own use at snack times and during lunch each day, but these items mentioned here for sale will be available for those who choose to purchase them.
