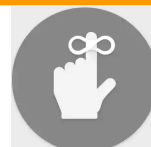
## Athletic Gate Fees

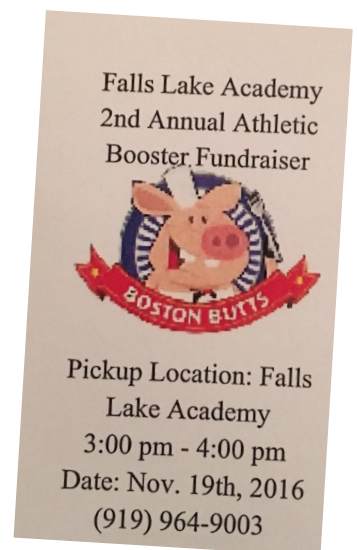
#### Acceptable Items:

## Athletic Booster Club

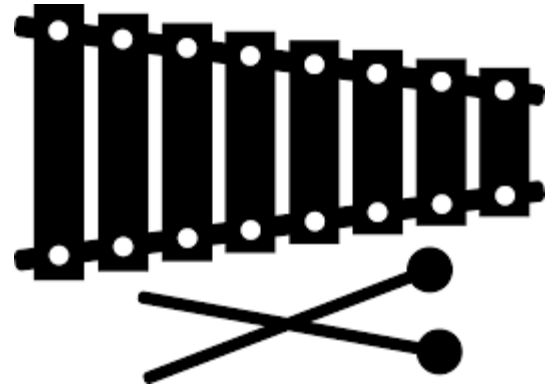

Please help support our sports teams and enjoy some great barbecue as well. We ask that you purchase tickets prior to 11-12-16 so we can accurately plan for this event.



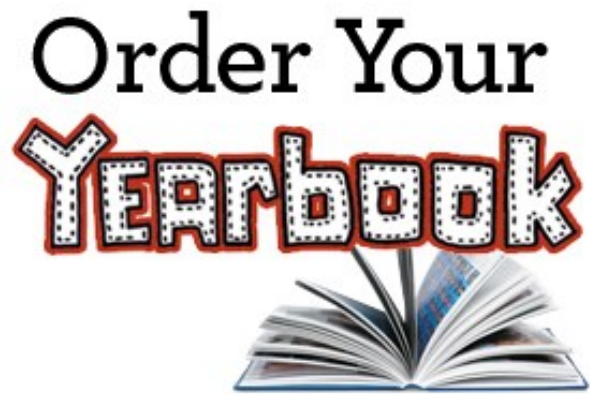
## Music News
